Route to STEM Scholarship - March 31st

Route to STEM Foundation, Inc. Scholarship

As part of our efforts to facilitate an increase in minority representation in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, the Route to STEM Foundation, Inc. awards annual scholarships to qualified applicants. The foundation currently offers four (4) scholarships:

- 1. The Route to STEM Scholarship awarded to a student pursuing a degree in the sciences, technology, engineering or mathematics (STEM) at any two-year or four year institution.
- 2. The Route to HBCU STEM Scholarship awarded to a student pursuing a STEM degree at any historically black college or university (HBCU).
- 3. The Route to FAMU STEM Scholarship awarded to a student pursuing a STEM degree at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU).

Application Period: January 1- March 31

Award Amounts: \$1000 each

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be from one or more racial/ethnic groups that are underrepresented in STEM (i.e. African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native American)
- 2. Must be a High School Senior who will graduate during the current academic school year
- 3. Must be accepted to a degree program in a field of Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics, at a Two-Year or Four-Year Institution.
- 4. Must have a minimum of a 2.75 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale
- 5. Must submit a completed scholarship application package, including academic transcript and two letters of recommendation, by March 31 of the application year.


American Legion Legacy Scholarship Application

- 1. Are you currently a high school senior and/or accepted at or attending an institution of higher education?
- 2. Is your institution of higher education a nonprofit and regionally-accredited institution? (If you are unsure, contact your institution's admission office. Regional accreditation applies to the whole school not a program.)
- 3. Does at least one of the following statements apply to you?
 - 1. A legal parent of mine died while serving on active duty, U.S. military service on or after September 11, 2001. (Does not have to be a death out-of-country or in combat.)
 - 2. A legal parent of mine is a Post-9/11 veteran of the U.S. military, who has been given a disability rating of 50% or higher by the Veterans Administration.

The 2023 Carl Van Williams Service Scholarship is a \$4,000 award created by Conyers Best Laundry and the family of Carl Van Williams in honor of the high level of community involvement displayed by Carl throughout his life. - *Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5/4.00. An official copy of his or her high school transcript must be included.
- *Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from a faculty member (high school or place of volunteer service).
- *Applicant must list the timeline, location and type of his or her community service involvement to be considered for the scholarship.
- *Applicant must complete an essay of 300-500 words about his or her volunteer work in the community. This can be with school, a youth group, a religious organization, a sports team or something else.
- *Applicant must provide a copy of his or her valid student id, state identification card or state driver's license.
- *Applicants may be asked to participate in an interview.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid in August 2023 or at the start of the academic term, directly to the college/ educational institution. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the scholarship committee at that time any information required to complete the payment.


The Collins Family Aspiraciones Más Grandes Scholarship 2023
